School drop-off could get a lot harder.

A 65-unit townhouse rezoning at 4482 & 4498 Gordon Drive would put every resident’s vehicle onto a single driveway, about 90 m from the school crosswalk your kids use.

The morning peak is already dangerous

An independent, time-stamped count on May 1, 2026 logged 400 vehicles in the 8:45 AM interval, with gaps under 3 seconds to merge — a level rated “dangerous.”

The applicant’s study missed it

Their traffic counts were taken over spring break — schools closed, buses not running — and collected no morning-peak data at all.

One access, beside the crosswalk

Drivers turning out past the existing hedge won’t have a clear sightline, forcing them forward onto the sidewalk children walk on every day.
